Twin size blankets/fitted sheets (not flat), **gloves, rain ponchos.**

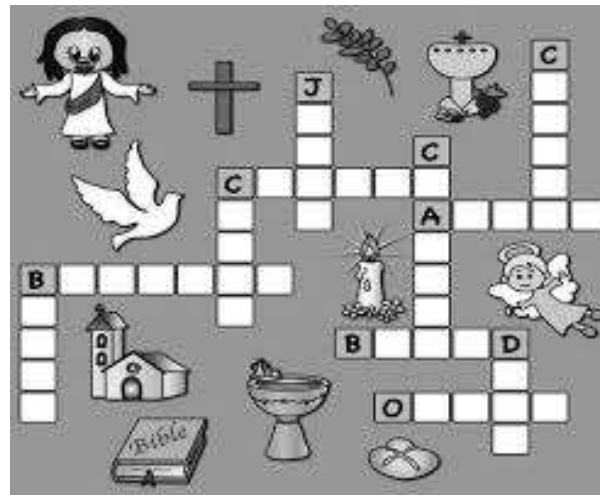
